**RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING DISABLED INDIVIDUALS TO
RESIDE IN ANN J. FERGUSON TOWERS**

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of Linden (“Housing Authority”), a public entity organized and existing pursuant to Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”), and the laws of the State of New Jersey, has determined that it would like to allow for disabled individuals to reside at Ann J. Ferguson Towers; and

WHEREAS, Ann J. Ferguson Towers is typically a senior-only housing building; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority would like to formally amend any of its applicable policies, including, but not limited to, the Authority’s Admissions and Continued Occupancy Policy (“ACOP”), to specifically allow for any disabled individuals, in addition to seniors, to reside at Ann J. Ferguson Towers; and


WHEREAS, upon review, the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority has found that the amendment of its policies to specifically allow for disabled individuals to reside at Ann J. Ferguson Towers is in the best interests of the Housing Authority and its overall goal of providing quality affordable housing to low-income individuals and seniors;

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the City of Linden hereby approves and authorizes the amendment of all applicable policies,

including, but not limited to, the ACOP, to allow for disabled individuals to reside at Ann J. Ferguson Towers; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board hereby authorizes and directs the Executive Director of the Housing Authority to take any and all necessary administrative actions to implement this resolution.
