WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of Linden ("Housing Authority"), a

public entity organized and existing pursuant to Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations, the

Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"), and the laws of the State of New

Jersey, has determined that it would like to install additional security cameras at Ann J. Ferguson

Towers; and

WHEREAS, having additional security cameras will enhance the safety and well-being

of Housing Authority residents by allowing the Authority to maintain a safe and secure

environment for its residents; and

WHEREAS, Millennium Communications Group, Inc. ("Millennium") has submitted a

proposal to the Housing Authority for the installation of additional security cameras at a cost of

\$5,957.10; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director has determined that the proposed cost is reasonable

and has recommended that the Housing Authority approve the contract with Millennium for the

installation of additional security cameras on the terms and conditions set forth above; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority has found that

installing additional security cameras at Ann J. Ferguson Towers is in the best interest of the

Housing Authority and its overall goal of providing quality affordable housing to low-income seniors;

## NOW THEREFORE,

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the City of Linden hereby approves and authorizes the installation of additional security cameras at Ann J. Ferguson Towers for the proposed cost of \$5,957.10; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Board hereby authorizes and directs the Executive Director of the Housing Authority to take any and all necessary administrative actions to implement this resolution.
