RESOLUTION RATIFYING A TEMPORARY SALARY INCREASE TO BRIAN DOOLEY FOR SERVING AS THE ACTING MAINTENANCE DIRECTOR

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of Linden ("Housing Authority"), a public

entity organized and existing pursuant to the Code of Federal Regulations, the U.S. Department of

Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"), and the laws of the State of New Jersey, determined

that it was in need of an Acting Maintenance Director; and

WHEREAS, specifically, the Housing Authority's Maintenance Director was on a leave

of absence; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure the efficient operation of the Housing Authority and the

timely completion of all maintenance tasks, the Housing Authority wished to appoint an Acting

Maintenance Director; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority determined that Assistant Maintenance Director Brian

Dooley was duly qualified to serve as the Acting Maintenance Director; and

WHEREAS, given the increased job responsibilities associated with this position, the

Housing Authority determined that Mr. Dooley shall receive a salary increase for serving as the

Acting Maintenance Director; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has found that it is in the best interest of the

Housing Authority and its overall goal of providing quality affordable housing to low-income

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seniors to ratify the temporary salary increase to Brian Dooley for serving as the Acting Maintenance Director;

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the City of Linden hereby ratifies the temporary salary increase to Brian Dooley for serving as the Acting Maintenance Director; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Mr. Dooley's salary shall be increased to \$105,876.90, effective August 20, 2018; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon the Maintenance Director's return to work, Mr. Dooley's service as the Acting Maintenance Director shall conclude and Mr. Dooley's salary shall return to the amount he was paid prior to service as Acting Maintenance Director; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board hereby directs the Executive Director of the Housing Authority to take any and all necessary administrative actions to implement this resolution.
