RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AND AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF AN INFRARED TEMPERATURE SENSING CAMERA

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of Linden ("Housing Authority"), a public

entity organized and existing pursuant to the Code of Federal Regulations, the U.S. Department of

Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"), and the laws of the State of New Jersey, has

determined that it is in need of purchasing an infrared temperature sensing camera; and

WHEREAS, specifically, the Housing Authority wishes to reduce staff and resident

exposure to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, an infrared temperature sensing camera would allow the Housing Authority

to identify potential cases of COVID-19 and take appropriate action; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority therefore desires to purchase an infrared temperature

sensing camera; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority's Qualified Purchasing Agent, Ann Marie Whelan,

has certified that this procurement is in compliance with all applicable Federal and State of New

Jersey procurement requirements, including but not limited to the Federal Procurement Standards

(2 C.F.R. 200.317 et seq.), the HUD Procurement Handbook (HUD Handbook 7460.8), the New

Jersey Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.), and the New Jersey Procurement

Regulations (N.J.A.C. 5:34-1.1 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority has certified that sufficient funds have been appropriated for the above-mentioned purchase; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interest of the Housing Authority and its overall goal of providing quality, affordable housing to low-income seniors to approve and authorize the purchase of an infrared temperature sensing camera;

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the City of Linden hereby approves and authorizes the purchase of an infrared temperature sensing camera; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Board hereby directs the Executive Director of the Housing Authority to take any and all necessary administrative actions to implement this resolution.
